Building information

Welcome to the Centenary Hospital for Women and Children

We hope this information sheet helps you access and locate areas within the Centenary Hospital.

Parking

Parking in front of the building is short term or drop off /set down only. For longer term car parking please utilise our large multistorey car park, which is located at the southern end of the campus.

Please follow the campus signage to find your way to the multistorey car park. All day parking is available at the far end of the car park across Yamba Drive.

Please be aware that all parking areas on the campus are regularly monitored and patrolled by parking inspectors.

Building Access

The Centenary Hospital main entrance is open between 6am and 9pm, and most areas are accessible to the public during these times.

Outside of these hours, including overnight, the main doors are locked and entry is only by contacting security.

There is a keypad immediately to the right, outside the main entrance doors, with instructions for how to contact security after-hours.

Once inside the building, within business hours utilise reception staff or out of hours follow the signage and the instructions outside the area you are hoping to enter.

Receptions

Most areas within the Centenary Hospital have a reception that is open normal or extended business hours.

Where to find services

Level 1

- Childbirth Education Room – Turn left on entering the building and follow the signage.
- Paediatrics Outpatients – Turn left on entering the building and continue down the corridor, on the right.

Level 2

- Postnatal ward
- Antenatal & Gynaecology ward
Turn right from lifts and follow corridor to the left.
- Maternity Assessment Unit (MAU)
- Fetal Medicine Unit (FMU) – contact reception on arrival
- Physiotherapy Maternity Gym
Turn left from lifts. Located part way down the corridor on the right.
- Zooki Cafe – open 8am – 8pm
Turn left from the lifts, half way along the corridor
- Maternity & Gynaecology Outpatients
Turn left down the corridor from lift. Further along the corridor past Zooki Cafe.
Contact reception on arrival.

Level 3

- Birth Centre – Rooms 1 - 5
Turn Right from lifts and around corner to the right. Contact reception on arrival.
- Birthing – Rooms 6 - 21 Reception open 6.30am – 6pm
Turn left from lifts. Birthing reception is on the right part way down the corridor.

Please note there is no public waiting area available.

- Hearing Screening: By appointment
Turn left from lifts. On your right, a short way further down the corridor from Birthing Reception.
- Neonatal Intensive Care & Special Care Nursery

Turn right from lifts. Behind the colourful '*where is the green sheep*' locked doors. Please note that access to these areas requires adherence to strict infection control and hand washing procedures.
