


Review of the Structure of Allied Health




Allied Health is the second largest clinical workforce group in ACT Health!

The mapping exercise is showing up some interesting facts and figures!

The staff in ACT Health Workforce Policy and Planning Unit (WPPU) have been working hard to extract, analyse and examine the Allied Health workforce across all divisions of the ACT Health structure and have found that there are 4825 clinical jobs occupied within ACT Health and that Allied Health is the second largest cohort in this group with 26% of the clinical jobs. Medical officers comprise 19% and nursing and midwifery comprise 55% of the total clinical jobs.

Clinical Job Groups by Headcount




The data from Workforce Policy and Planning is the authoritative source of workforce data within ACT Health and is relied upon to provide health workforce reporting aligning activity and financial needs of the organisation. The data is extracted directly from the pay records of shared services and it is acknowledged that the data is a

snapshot from the date it is collected but the workforce is ever changing.

The allied health workforce is separated into three work areas. The majority of allied health staff, 62%, work in the therapeutic area. Our scientific and project teams make up the other 38% of allied health staff.

Project Reference Group
