

Radiation Oncology Nurse Led Clinic

Follow up care after radiation treatment

The Radiation Oncology Nurse Led Clinic is for radiation oncology patients. You can access the clinic for up to 6 weeks after your treatment, or under the direction of the treating Radiation Oncologist.

The nurses at the clinic can:

- check your skin and help you manage any skin reactions you have had from the radiation. They can also help you with other radiation induced symptoms
- give you routine early follow-up care after your treatment if you have breast implants or tissue expanders within 7 to 10 days after you have completed your radiation treatment
- give you medicines or infusions that your treating radiation oncologist has recommended
- arrange for you to be seen by the medical team if necessary
- refer you to other health professionals if you need them
- give you more information after your treatment about how to manage any symptoms from radiotherapy
