Thanks for getting onto this.

I note that the option of using the Carpark lift to satisfy DDA was recommended by CHS and may be necessary to manage costs (to be confirmed) – I'm not sure we can say its not recommended at the moment, happy for both options to be reviewed for discussion with providers though (unless there is further information I'm not aware of). Obviously, if the single storey option is shown to be the most efficient solution, this will become a moot point.

Not necessarily for the discussion with modular providers, but more broadly on the S&D Exec demountable side of things:

- I understand there was a previous solution STH put forward which included some surface car parking
 (potentially nose to curb off Hospital Road) near where we are planning the demountable, could we look at
 this further and see if we might get some additional offset parking and allow for some exec parking directly
 outside the building. Happy for IFCW to workshop with STH to see what the best/most efficient
 configuration is for the site though; and
- In the context of program and consultation requirements, the SOA will need to be further developed with the whole of government accommodation policy in mind, and there will be an approval process with the Directorate Office Accommodation Committee (DOAC) (ACT Property Group Kate Kennedy is the contact). I have asked Rhona to investigate what additional documentation exists to support the development of SOAs within the 12m2 allowances (ratio of quiet rooms, meeting rooms etc.), but I would appreciate any insight IFCW has in relation to the office accommodation policies held by CSI.

Happy to discuss in more detail tomorrow.
