Health Professionals Classification Review

- What is the Authority for the review?
 - Established under the Enterprise Agreement (Annex E)
- What is the purpose of the review?
 - To address the relevance of the structure as applied to Allied Health Professionals
- Who is going to conduct the review?
 - The review is managed by a Joint CHS/Unions Working Party. A dedicated Project Manager will conduct the review.

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- Is the review underway?
 - The review is in the establishment phase, which includes establishing the
 - Joint Working Party (JWP)
 - Terms of Reference
 - Project Methodology
 - Communications Plan, and
 - staffing and resourcing.

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- Can I be involved in the review?
- Direct employee involvement may be by:
 - sub-committees established by the JWP,
 - responding to requests for information,
 - by participating in interviews, group meetings, and
 - any general employee information sessions scheduled.
- Generally, employees will not be involved in the Joint Working Party conducting the review as this is determined by the enterprise agreement and the JWP Terms of Reference.
