### **DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION**

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act), received by ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) on **Monday 29 June 2020**.

This application requested access to:

*'I would like all documents including but not limited to Microsoft Team documents, relating to the termination or finalisation of employment of Mr Bradley Burch from the ACT Public Service.'*

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act. ACTHD was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Monday 27 July 2020**.

#### **Decision**

Documents have been identified holding the relevant information within the scope of your access application. All documents relevant to your application were also identified documents relevant to an application you submitted previously (FOI20-28). I have decided to consider these applications as one application in accordance with section 43 (2) of the Act. Therefore, the decision on access to this information is contained in the response to FOI20-28 provided **Thursday 23 July 2020**.

#### **Charges**

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

#### **Disclosure Log**

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, ACTHD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. The scope of your access application and my decision released to you will be published in the disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. #### **Ombudsman review**

ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal (ACAT) review


