

Overnight Dexamethasone Suppression Test

You should follow the steps below:

Step 1

Please take the script for Dexamethasone tablets that you have received from your doctor to the Pharmacy Department at the Canberra Hospital.

Step 2

Day 1: Please take the two tablets at **11pm** (2300hrs) on the evening before you can come for a blood test

Step 3

Day 2: Please attend the following collection centre the morning after taking the tablets **between 8am and 9am** to have a blood test. Inform the attending staff at the collection centre that it is important to have the blood specimens taken between 8am and 9am.
