DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act), received by ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) on **Wednesday 16 February 2022**.

This application requested access to:

'All documents prepared in relation to providing a media statement to The Canberra Times on Thursday, February 3 2022 regarding the vaccination statuses of people in the ACT who had died from COVID-19 in January 2022.

This request includes draft responses and correspondence relating to the request.'

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Director-General of ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act. ACTHD was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Thursday 17 March 2022**.

I have identified 33 documents holding the information within scope of your access application. These are outlined in the schedule of documents included at <u>Attachment A</u> to this decision letter.

Decisions on access

I have decided to grant partial access to 33 documents. My access decisions are detailed further in the following statement of reasons and the documents released to you are provided as Attachment B to this letter.

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act;
- The contents of the documents that fall within the scope of your request;
- The views of relevant third parties; and
- The Human Rights Act 2004.

Public Interest Factors Favouring Disclosure

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the disclosure of the documents:

- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability; and
- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest.

<u>Public Interest Factors Favouring Non-Disclosure</u>

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the non-disclosure of the documents:

• Schedule 2, Schedule 2.2 (a)(ii) prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the Human Rights Act 2004.

The documents contain information that I consider, on balance, to be contrary to the public interest to disclose under the test set out in section 17 of the Act as the information contained in these folios is partially comprised of personal information. The redacted information contains mobile phone numbers and email addresses of both ACT and non-ACT government employees. In addition, some redactions have been made where the disclosure of this information may potentially identify the relevant individuals.

Therefore, I have decided this factor outweighs the public interest factors in the disclosure of this information.

Charges

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

Disclosure Log

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, ACTHD maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. The scope of your access application, my decision and documents released to you will be published in the disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

Ombudsman review

My decision on your access request is a reviewable decision as identified in Schedule 3 of the FOI Act. Hi Robyn

We can provide data on vaccination status for those who have died and for those who have been hospitalised, however, we are unable to provide any further information on these cases for privacy/confidentiality reasons. Whole genome sequencing is unavailable for a number of these cases so we will not be supplying this information.

I am not comfortable providing any info on such a small group of cases i.e. not for 2022 alone. I know we were asked for data since 13 December, but those numbers are very small once breakdowns are reported. To be safe, we have supplied vax data for all deaths during this outbreak and on hospitalisations for the whole pandemic.

There were 3 deaths prior to the current outbreak, however they occurred before vaccines were developed so are not included here.
