#### **DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION**

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act), received by Canberra Health Services (CHS) on **Friday 17 February 2023.** 

This application requested access to:

Copies of any correspondence within the directorates and/or the minister's office regarding CHSFOI 22-23.30.

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of CHS under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act. CHS was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Monday 20 March 2023.** 

I have identified six documents holding the information within scope of your access application. These are outlined in the schedule of documents included at <u>Attachment A</u> to this decision letter.

## **Decisions on access**

I have decided to:

- · grant full access to four documents; and
- · grant partial access to two documents.

My access decisions are detailed further in the following statement of reasons and the documents released to you are provided as <u>Attachment B</u> to this decision letter.

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act;
- The contents of the documents that fall within the scope of your request;
- The views of relevant third parties; and
- The Human Rights Act 2004.

#### **Full Access**

I have decided to grant full access to four documents at references 1-2, 4 and 6.

## **Partial Access**

I have decided to grant partial access to two documents at refences 3 and 5 as it contains information that I consider, on balance to be contrary to the public interest to disclose under the test set out in section 17 of the FOI Act.

#### **Public Interest Factors Favouring Disclosure**

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the disclosure of the documents:

- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability; and
- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest.

### Public Interest Factors Favouring Non-Disclosure

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the non-disclosure of the documents:

• Schedule 2, Schedule 2.2 (a)(ii) prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2004*.

On balance, the factors favouring disclosure did not outweigh the factor favouring non-disclosure as the redacted information contains the mobile phone number of an ACT Government employee. Therefore, I determined the information identified is contrary to the public interest and I have decided not to disclose this information.

## Charges

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

## **Disclosure Log**

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, CHS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. The scope of your access application and my decision released to you will be published in the disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. Your personal contact details will not be published.

#### Ombudsman review

As the Principal Officer of CHS, I am authorised to make a decision on access or amendment to government information in the possession or control of CHS. CHS was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Monday 16 January 2023**.

#### Decisions

I am notifying you of my intention to refuse to deal with your access application, in accordance with section 43 of the FOI Act;

• Section 43 (1)(a) dealing with the application would require an unreasonable and substantial diversion of the respondent's resources.

The resources required to collate all the briefs requested would require extensive examination across multiple business areas and/or individual staff within the agency. I have decided this is an unreasonable and substantial diversion of resources.

The extent to which the public interest would be advanced by processing this access application is difficult to quantify as it covers such a broad range of subject matters. The resources required to process this application would substantially inhibit the ability of multiple areas of CHS to exercise their primary functions. It is my decision that the possible public interest benefits in the disclosure of this information do not justify the use of the required resources.

Under section 46 of the Act, CHS must take reasonable steps to assist you and give you a consultation period of 10 working days from  $\underline{\text{the date of this letter}}$  to make an application in a form that would remove the grounds for refusal under the FOI Act.

You may wish to refine/reduce the scope of your request, and if you do, the day the amended application is received becomes the commencement date of the decision process. Additionally, you may consider other avenues the information you are seeking can be obtained.

Both Directorates have considered your response and believe that this still does not remove the grounds outlined in the initial intention to refuse letters sent to you on Thursday 22 December 2022 from the ACT Health Directorate (ACTHD) and Friday 23 December 2022 from Canberra Health Services (CHS). To separate the applications into smaller packages; being divided by business units, types of briefs, etc., would likely increase the workload of each involved business area, still resulting in an unreasonable and substantial diversion of resources.

You may wish to reduce the number of briefs requested to each Directorate in line with what has previously been provided to you in your other similar applications.

Under section 46 of the Act, ACTHD and CHS must take reasonable steps to assist you and give you a consultation period of 10 working days from the date of the notice of intention to refuse letter to make an application in a form that would remove the grounds for refusal under the FOI Act. You may wish to provide an additional response. The Directorate is willing to extend the consultation date until the close of business **Wednesday 25 January 2023**.
