### **DECISION ON YOUR ACCESS APPLICATION**

I refer to your application under section 30 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016* (FOI Act), received by Canberra Health Services (CHS) on **Wednesday 5 July 2023**.

This application requested access to:

All documents related to Question on Notice 1176.

I am an Information Officer appointed by the Chief Executive Officer of Canberra Health Services (CHS) under section 18 of the FOI Act to deal with access applications made under Part 5 of the Act. CHS was required to provide a decision on your access application by **Wednesday 16 August 2023**.

I have identified 25 documents holding the information within scope of your access application. These are outlined in the schedule of documents included at Attachment A<sub>\_to</sub> this decision letter.

# **Decisions on access**

I have decided to:

- grant full access to two documents; and
- grant partial access to 23 documents.

My access decisions are detailed further in the following statement of reasons and the documents released to you are provided as <u>Attachment B</u> to this letter.

In reaching my access decision, I have taken the following into account:

- The FOI Act;
- The contents of the documents that fall within the scope of your request;
- The views of relevant third parties; and
- The Human Rights Act 2004.

#### **Full Access**

I have decided to grand full access to two documents at references 8 and 24.

# Partial Access

I have decided to grand partial access to 23 documents at references 1-7, 9-23 and 25 as they contain information that I consider to be contrary to the public interest to disclose under the test set out in section 17 of the FOI Act.

# Public Interest Factors Favouring Disclosure

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the disclosure of the documents:

- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(i) promote open discussion of public affairs and enhance the government's accountability; and
- Schedule 2, 2.1(a)(ii) contribute to positive and informed debate on important issues or matters of public interest.

# Public Interest Factors Favouring Non-Disclosure

The following factors were considered relevant in favour of the non-disclosure of the documents:

• Schedule 2, 2.2 (a)(ii) prejudice the protection of an individual's right to privacy or any other right under the *Human Rights Act 2004*.

On balance, the factors favouring disclosure did not outweigh the factor favouring non-disclosure as the redacted information contains mobile phone numbers and superannuation details of ACT Government employees. Therefore, I determined the information identified is contrary to the public interest and I have decided not to disclose this information.

#### Charges

Processing charges are not applicable to this request.

# **Disclosure Log**

Under section 28 of the FOI Act, CHS maintains an online record of access applications called a disclosure log. The scope of your access application, my decision and documents released to you will be published in the disclosure log not less than three days but not more than 10 days after the date of this decision. # **Ombudsman review**







About one third of my team are specific project positions – Brand, CSB and other infrastructure etc. We also have dedicated permanent funding for a research position to support Office for Research and Education.

All communication and engagement positions at CHS are centralised within the Branch and then provide account management services.

My understanding is this is done differently at ACT Health. For example comms for DHR sat within the DHR team, COVID comms sits within the business area, there was a culture position within the culture reform branch etc. More recently North Canberra Hospital transition has had a separate comms team. I know way back pop health had comms as well. I don't know if this is still the case.

So I'm guessing (stress guessing) that it is that different approach – centralised comms providing account management versus comms embedded within business areas – may be why there's a small difference in staffing numbers. The reality is once our current projects are completed we are likely to have significantly less staff.

In terms of operational: the main budget items in my 22-23 budget aside from staffing were advertising and promotional expenses, computer and communication, website, contractors and consultants, staff development.


